SAFE USE AND HANDLING ASSESSMENT - HOLDER



Dear Licensed Firearm Holder,

Effective January 1, 2016 the Firearm Licensing Authority [FLA] will require that all holders of Firearm Licences, Certificates and/or Permits, successfully do the FLA Safe Use and Handling Assessment in order to complete the annual Renewal Process.

The assessment will be conducted at any FLA Certified Range by a FLA Certified Trainer, who will afterwards complete the prescribed form and give to the candidate, for submission to FLA. During each assessment [which is required once every 3 years], the Firearm Licence Holder [FLH] shall demonstrate that he/she can:

1. Safely handle a firearm by:

- Drawing, Presenting, and Holstering his/her firearm
- Loading and Unloading his/her firearm

2. Safely use a:

- Pistol or revolver by hitting each ⁱtarget with at least three out of five rounds.
- Shotgun or rifle, by hitting two out of three ⁱⁱtargets

3. Use of Force

- Candidate will be required to participate in the FLA prescribed *Use of Force* lecture.

A fee of no more than one thousand five hundred dollars [\$1500] will be charged, by the assessor. The assessment fee does not include the cost of ammunition or the range entry fee.

ⁱ 2 Cardboard Targets 9 ft and 15 ft in-front of the line of fire (6 feet apart). Total 10 rounds.

ⁱⁱ 3 steel plates placed 45ft in front the line of fire (3 feet apart). Total 6 rounds.
